BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That the appeal of the Historic District Landmarks Commission's (HDLC) decision of "conceptual approval" for the retention of modifications to the cooling tower without a Certificate of Appropriateness for property located at 3500 St. Claude Avenue be approved, allowing the retention of modifications to the cooling tower only if additional screening measures are adopted, with approval from the HDLC and/or ARC, alongside the required fast-growing trees.
