This letter confirms the actions of the New Orleans Historic District Landmarks Commission at its meeting Wednesday, April 6, 2022, concerning your application for the following work: Demolition of more than 50% of existing roof structure for second story addition at a contributing one-story, commercial building.

At that time the Commission voted to: Approve the application for partial roof demolition. Please submit one set of stamped, final detailed drawings. Following review, we will contact you regarding any errors, omissions, or changes. All drawings should be submitted to Staff via email. Once approved, these drawings will then be transmitted internally to Safety & Permits for their review and permitting. As such, it is important that the final drawings are sufficient for review by both Departments. Keep in mind that only the amount of demolition indicated in the HDLC approved drawings is authorized. Please contact me directly should existing conditions necessitate review of additional demolition or re-framing work. Demolishing additional square footage without the proper approvals can result in costly delays and fines.
