This letter confirms the actions of the New Orleans Historic District Landmarks Commission at its meeting Wednesday, July 6, 2022, concerning your application for the following work: Demolition of a Contributing rated, one-story, single-family residential building to grade.

At that time the Commission voted to:

Deny the application for demolition to grade based on the condition of the structure today, because it continues to contribute its type, style, scale, massing, roof form and footprint to the tout ensemble of the surrounding local historic district, and because there are alternatives to full demolition that can be further explored by the applicant which would allow for the renovation and rehabilitation of the existing historic building.

Should you wish to appeal the Commission's decision to the City Council you must provide a written request for appeal addressed to the Clerk of Council, City Hall, Room 1E09, New Orleans, LA 70112 within ten (10) calendar days of the Commission meeting.
