This letter confirms the actions of the New Orleans Historic District Landmarks Commission at its meeting Tuesday, October 4, 2022, concerning your application for the following work: Retention of demolition of more than 50% of the exterior walls of an existing Contributing rated two-story, single-family residential building without a Certificate of Appropriateness.

At that time the Commission voted to:

Defer action on this application until the next Commission meeting so that the applicant may have additional time to work with HDLC Staff to verify the date of demolition. If the date of the demolition cannot be definitively confirmed as prior to August 1st then the application will be subject to the current enhanced demolition fine structure. This item has been placed on the agenda of the next New Orleans HDLC Commission meeting to be held on Wednesday, November 2nd, 2022. The meeting will be held beginning at 1:30 p.m. and will be conducted in-person in the City Council Chamber of City Hall, 1300 Perdido Street. A copy of the agenda will be emailed to the contact address on file prior to the meeting.
