Definition of Terms

- Administrative Compensation: Monies paid to contractor for duties that consist of site visits, product and material acquisition, Vendor and subcontractor relations, permit and inspection filing, Negotiating with product distributors, office management and all activity and communication associated with a particular project.
- Change Order: An alteration or adjustment to the scope of work to accommodate a change requested by the client or the contractor
- Distributor: A supplier that provide a product or material for a project
- Draw Request: A written or verbal request by a contractor for additional money for the purpose of addressing a change order or an unexpected expense to assure the smooth conduinity of the project.
- Labor: The physical manual work that is expected to be done to complete the project which consist of installing parts, equipment and building materials.
- Laborer: The hired helper that will work alongside the technician or subcontractor to perform the physical manual labor on a project
- Payment Schedule: The rate and frequency a contractor is to be paid according to the contract agreement, which is often in par with the schedule of value of work that is performed and completed
- Schedule of Value: The value of the work that is being performed
 which represents the dollar amount of a particular scope and its
 portion of the overall project. Example: Carpentry \$100 of a \$1000
 project means the value of the Carpentry is 10% of the total project.
- Skilled Laborer: A hired helper that is certified, licensed or bonded in a certain field and have a unique skill set to perform the task he is hired to do.
